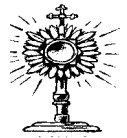
WANTED – MASS INTENTIONS

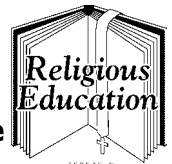

Show Appreciation

As we enjoy our participation in the **Holy Sacrifice** of the **Mass**, let us recall the many ways we show our appreciation for what we are experiencing. We listen, in silence, during the **Liturgy of the Word**. We make our voices heard, in prayer responses and in song, as we make that joyful noise unto the Lord. And, we spend time after receiving **Holy Communion**, telling **God** how much we appreciate **His** presence within us. These are personal acts of appreciation that we know and should put into practice. Occasionally, while at **Mass**, we want to offer an outward show of appreciation for a job well done such as a special presentation by the choir, the children or one of our priests or parishioners. Or we may wish to acknowledge an anniversary or a renewal of vows celebration. In these instances, our natural instinct tells us to clap our hands, a universal sign of appreciation. This is an acceptable gesture at **Mass** if done at the proper time. **NEVER** should clapping interrupt the **Sacrifice** of the **Mass**! So acknowledge the choir, we remain in Church until the end of the **Mass** and then we may clap our appreciation. To acknowledge an anniversary or renewal of vows, we clap **after** the celebrant has made the introductions and **before** he has resumed saying **Mass**. **God** loves fun, **He** wants us to be happy and to make that joyful noise! We offer this all to **Him** as we mind our manners.
