WORDS FROM FATHER MICHAEL



One of the more thought-provoking images in our Gospel story is that of a locked door. John's Gospel describes the disciples hiding in fear within a set of locked doors. In spite of that, Jesus appears to them and offers a simple greeting: "Peace be with you."

The message is a powerful one: that Christ surpasses all barriers and boundaries – that he will enter our lives, no matter how hard we try to keep him out. And he comes bearing a message of peace.

When we ponder the depths of God's love and our hunger for his mercy, we might ask ourselves: what are the doors that are keeping Christ out of our lives? How have we locked them? How can we unlock them?

Fear and uncertainty are among the most stubborn obstacles, preventing us from truly being open to God's love for us. The Gospel asks us to look more deeply at the barriers that might be keeping him out - and to realize that he comes to us bearing the gift of peace.
