Tips on inviting friends and family to the Catholic Church or back to the church.

**SET A GOOD EXAMPLE**

**Focus** on your one faith experience. Do you constantly criticize the Church? Or do you project a sense of joy, peace, love and enthusiasm?

**Pray** for the person.

**Love** unconditionally. When the rich young man walked away, Jesus looked at him with love.

**Invite** them not only to Mass but also to parish lectures, concerts, social events, Scripture study and even service projects.

**Do Not Nag** - it never works.

**Stay Informed** to make sure you have correct information when talking to someone who is away from the Church or is interested in the Church.

Help people who are thinking about returning to the Church find a parish where they feel comfortable. Sometimes people who have been involved with Pentecostals do best in a charismatic parish. People who have been in fundamentalist churches may want a parish with Scripture study. Some like the anonymity of a large, suburban parish. Some seek the intimacy of a small parish. Some look for traditional liturgies or devotions. Others look for a way to work toward social justice. Allow the **HOLY SPIRIT** to work through you. Before long, you'll begin to see that people will be attracted to the Church because they want the faith, the love and the peace you possess.

**SCHOOL NEWS**

ATTENTION: Business People - Accountants, Lawyers, architects, Corporations (including subchapter-S), Partnerships

Did you know you can give from your state taxes to our Catholic school? The Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program allows certain businesses including subchapter S-corporations, to give up to \$300,000 a year to St. Malachy School. When you make an EITC donation, you receive a 90% tax credit if you give for two consecutive years (and 75% credit for one year). The money goes towards tuition assistance for needy families. As an example, the net cost for a company to give a \$10,000 EITC Contribution (for two years) is approximately \$450, annually.

There is state tax credit money available for 2010 beginning July 1st. Contact the school office at 412-771-4545, and you will be contacted by someone who can help you fill out the form, which requests minimal information.

Please consider taking advantage of this unique Pennsylvania program that allows businesses to contribute portions of their state taxes to benefit their Catholic school, at minimal cost.
