## FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

### WORDS FROM FATHER MICHAEL



At the Last Supper, Jesus tells his apostles: "As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. All will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." For that kind of love would remain impossible for us if it were not for the love of Jesus Christ.

Blessed Teresa of Calcutta said, "The less we have, the more we give. Seems absurd, but it's the logic of love." She goes on to say, "True love causes pain. Jesus, in order to give us proof of his love died on the cross. A mother, in order to give birth to her baby, has to suffer. If you really love one another, you will not be able to avoid making sacrifices."

Today fifty-seven of our young people will receive Jesus in Holy Communion for the first time. This is a special time of grace, a special time for the child, a special time for the family and a special time for our parish. This time is special because Holy Communion is Jesus' sign of love for us. Jesus was willing to give his life on the cross and he was willing to give his very self in Holy Communion for us. Jesus truly loves us. We are called to follow Jesus' example by loving one another. To recite Jesus' law of love means nothing; to live it is everything. What sacrifice of love are we willing to give to one another?

**BREAST CANCER ALERT**

Breast cancer is the most common cancer among women and the second leading cause of cancer death in women today. Over the last ten years, the death rate from **breast cancer** has significantly **declined** among younger women because of **early detection** and more effective treatment methods. Breast self-examination, clinical breast examination and mammography help to detect cancer in its early stage. Early detection increases the chances of a complete cure.

**BREAST SELF-EXAMINATION**

Breast self-exam would be performed monthly by all women by the age of 20. The self-exam involves:

☞ Self-examination once a month, several days after your monthly.

☞ Self-examination on the first of the month if you do not have your monthly.

☞ Requesting a free breast self examination card by calling 1-800-462-9273 or [www.komen.org/bse](http://www.komen.org/bse).

**CLINICAL BREAST EXAMINATION**

The breast and underarms are examined by a health professional:

☞ Looking for lumps and changes in tissue structure.

☞ Every three years between the ages of 20 and 39.

☞ Every year after 40 years of age.

**MAMMOGRAM**

A Mammogram is an X-ray of the breast, which can detect an abnormality well before it can be felt. Mammography is the best screening method for finding breast cancer early. This procedure is highly recommended for women who have a family history of breast cancer.

**Early detection** is the **KEY**. One should start at a young age to develop the habit of practicing detection methods. As one ages the risk of developing breast cancer increases. According to the National Cancer Institute, it is estimated that at the age of 30 the chances are 1 in 50. Then by the age of 80 the chances of breast cancer are 1 in 10.
