WHY DO WE FAST ONE HOUR BEFORE COMMUNION

The ancient discipline of fasting before Communion became a universal practice by the fifth century. Until 1953, everyone refrained from consuming food, water, gum and medicine from midnight to the time of Communion. In 1953 and 1957, Pope Pius XII reduced the fast from food to three hours and from water for one hour. In 1966 Pope Paul VI further reduced the fast to one hour and allowed water and medicine at any time. In 1973 he reduced the fast for the sick and elderly to fifteen minutes before Communion when one hour is prohibitive. The loosening of the restrictions was in no way intended to lessen the reverence for the Eucharist. The changes were made to allow as many Catholics as possible to receive the Eucharist, which can be difficult when priests are in short supply. For the same reason, *Immensae Caritatis* (Immense Love) also allowed the practice of having extraordinary ministers give Communion. Despite the changes to the Communion fast, unity and uniformity have been maintained. Catholics are free to fast before Communion beyond the duration and degree currently prescribed. Fasting before Communion includes **no** chewing of gum.
