## THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

MAY 30, 2010

### WORDS FROM

#### FATHER MICHAEL

Peter denied Christ three times. Jesus rose on the third day. Jesus told Peter three times to "Feed my sheep." So many things come in threes: Faith, hope and charity. The Magi. Past, present and future. Priest, prophet and king. The triangle has been described as the most durable shape there is. Its three sides and three angles make it a "perfect" figure that will never collapse into another form. Circles might become ovals, for example – but even if you compress them, triangles will always be triangles. The greatest triangle of all is the Trinity.

Every Sunday we profess our faith in one God. Every time we make the sign of the cross we acknowledge that the one God we worship and adore is also a Trinity of persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. God is an unfathomable mystery of three persons pouring themselves out in love for one another throughout all of eternity. Most importantly, can we bring this mystery to life by pouring ourselves out for one another in love after the example of our triune God?

### CORPUS CHRISTI

The Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ will be celebrated next Sunday, June 6th. This feast emphasizes the true presence of Jesus in the consecrated bread and wine that we receive at Mass. A tradition of this feast is to have a procession. In this procession the Blessed Sacrament is carried in a vessel called a monstrance.

Next Sunday, after the 11:00 a.m. Mass the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on our altar here at St. Malachy for all to spend some quiet prayer time with our Blessed Lord. Beginning at 2:30 p.m. there will be prayers, a procession of the Blessed Sacrament to our school gymnasium and Benediction. Please join us for this wonderful tradition of our Church as we worship and adore our Eucharistic Lord.
