PRO-LIFE NEWS

Using brain scans an international team of scientists has taken a look inside the brains of patients diagnosed as being in a "vegetative state." These patients, the images clearly showed, were living silently, their mind apparently active, the scans showing brain activity like that in any healthy conscious person. (New York Times, 2/4/10) This counteracts the arguments that such patients are "in a vegetative state," and can be starved to death as Terry Schiavo was in 2005.
