The story of the good Samaritan has become one of the favorites for Christians over the years. You only have to look at classical paintings, stained glass windows, or pictures in family Bibles to see how often the parable is illustrated. Our familiarity with the story has lessened off some of the impact that would have instantly hit the first readers of Luke's Gospel. Let me put it this way: if you were in trouble, how would you react if the person who came to help you was an Iranian or North Korean official, an illegal immigrant, or the member of an ethnic group that you may have recently criticized? So who is your neighbor?

HOW OFTEN CAN YOU RECEIVE COMMUNION?

According to official norms, a Catholic may receive Communion a second time on a given day if he or she participates in two Masses that are not celebrated in immediate succession and that are truly distinct celebrations of the Eucharist. One of the purposes of this norm is to assist in avoiding the impression that the more times one attends Mass and receives Communion on the same day the better. It is the quality of one's attendance at the liturgy, rather than the quantity, that matters most.

BISHOPS URGE SENATE TO REMOVE

ABORTION AMENDMENT FROM DEFENSE BILL

Cardinal Daniel DiNardo said that the amendment is "moderate" in requiring patients at military facilities to pay for their abortions. "However, it is a more direct governmental involvement in abortion because the government reimburses someone else for having done an abortion, or that the government profits the abortion itself and accepts payment for doing so?"

The Cardinal wrote: A 1989 ruling by the U.S. Supreme Court saying that "the State need not commit any resources to facilitating abortions, even if it can turn a profit by doing so." Cardinal DiNardo also noted the longstanding nature of the current policy against providing abortions at military health facilities, which has been in place for 22 years.

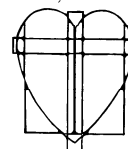
