In today's Gospel, Mary and Martha are both attending to hospitality. Martha runs around preparing food and getting cups and bowls ready. Mary puts all her energy into listening to what Jesus has to say. Martha is anxious about making things perfect for Jesus, but Jesus tells her that what Mary has chosen to do at that time is very important. Jesus wishes to be received with true hospitality, for his own sake, and not just in order to enhance one's reputation for being a gracious host or hostess.

When you go to someone's home to visit, what is more important to you: that the placemats and napkins match the flowers in the center-piece, or that the person you are visiting is paying attention to you, listening to you, and enjoying your company?

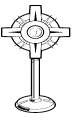
### MASS TO HONOR
